Campsite Preferences

Campsite Sizes

Campsites will be based on an approximate measure of 8m x 8m. Generally these sizes are met, however in some instances measurements will vary.

Campsite Power

Access to power is available on all campsites.

Campground Operating Times

The Campground opens at 8am on Tuesday 14 November and closes at 7.30am on Monday 20 November 2017. Access to the Campground will not be permitted before the specified opening time and patrons are to depart the Circuit by specified closing time. The campground office will only be open for 'check in' from 8am to 6pm daily. Please note the circuit will be closed for driver rides/instruction on 20 and 21 November 2017, therefore all patrons must depart the Circuit by 7.30am on this day.

Payments Options & Refunds

No booking will be taken without payment. Payment can be made in the form of credit card or direct debit and must be received before reservations can be confirmed. **NO REFUNDS** will be provided after 10 November 2017.

The Event is free of charge therefore no tickets need be purchased.

Vehicles

STRICTLY one (1) vehicle pass per campsite booked will be provided with exception to motorcycles where two (2) vehicle passes may be issued. All vehicles are the responsibility of the owner and must be contained within the confines of the campsite/s. If your vehicle and/or accommodation facilities exceed the campsite size you are required to purchase an additional site. A tow away service will be in operation for any vehicles that are not parked completely within the allotted campsite. Additional cars of campers may be parked in the General Car Park located adjacent to the Main Ticket Gate. Campers must include their contact name and number on their vehicle pass.

CAMPGROUND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PROHIBITED ITEMS

You must comply with the terms and conditions appearing on your e-ticket, all Event signs and instructions and directions from the Event Organiser, Police, Security and Officials. Special policies you must abide by are as follows:

- NO fireworks, explosions or illegal substances (patrons maybe subject to search)
- NO couches and lounge chairs
- NO unregistered motorised wheeled devices
- NO glass bottles
- NO donuts, burnouts or burning of vehicles
- NO animals (excluding companion animals)
- NO temporary platforms to be erected
- NO petrol canisters over 5 litres in capacity
- NO weapons

CAMPGROUND RULES

- Reasonable behaviour is expected at all times. Police and/or security will enforce eviction for disorderly conduct and other misbehaviour.
- The Event Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to the campgrounds to any person deemed unfit or inappropriate in its discretion.
- If your vehicle or accommodation facilities exceed the campsite size, you are required to purchase an additional site. A tow away service will be in operation for any vehicles that are not parked completely within the allotted campsite.
- Use of vehicles within the campgrounds for unlawful/ dangerous practise is strictly forbidden.
- Identification vehicle passes must be affixed to the vehicle and clearly visible.

1. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in refusal of entry to or removal from the Event venue.
2. The Event Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, damage, claim or demand suffered by any person(s) as a result (directly or indirectly) of non-compliance with these conditions and the campground rules.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Sites are approximately 8m x 8m in size, however may vary slightly.
- The fee to book a campsite is fixed, regardless of the number of nights you stay.
- All campsites have access to power.
- Alcohol is permitted as long as it is not in glass bottles and of a reasonable amount.
- Campfires are permitted provided there are no fire restrictions in place. Campfires must be contained at all times and stay within the boundary of the campsite.
- The campground area has sufficient amenities (toilets and showers) for both male and female patrons.
- Security guards will patrol the campground areas however the event takes no responsibility for camper's belongings.
